TEACHING SUMMARY:

The 1st Century Church saw God's power work through them because they were devoted to Jesus and lived obediently to Him as Lord.

In this week's teaching, we see four keystone habits that the first disciples devoted themselves to and we learned about the impact it had on those who were in the Church family. That impact, along with their testimony, was a witness of the gospel to those who were far from God.

Their devotion to Jesus built an unshakeable faith that persevered through persecution, poverty, and peril.
